



2020 Athletic Guidelines



1. It is recommended that all spectators wear a face covering at all Fort Benton athletic events.
2. All Players, Managers, Coaches, etc. will be required to wear a face covering while not actively participating in the competition.
3. Children under 12 years of age and under are required to be with an adult at all times.
4. Physical Distancing is encouraged at all athletic events
 - a. Volleyball Specifics
 - i. Lower level seating is only available for Fort Benton students, handicap, and seniors.
 - ii. Once seated, fans are asked to remain in their seating section. When fans go to the restroom or concessions, we ask that you wear a mask and adhere to physical distancing guidelines. Bleachers will be marked off in Pods of 50. We ask that you remain in the same pod the entire game.
 - b. Football Specifics
 - i. Please practice physical distancing at all times while inside the gate. We will have the bleachers marked off in PODS of 50. Please sit in the same area the entire game. Those not in bleachers should practice physical distancing. Masks are recommended at all times.
5. Concessions will be available for all fans. We ask that you wear a mask at all times while traveling to and from concessions. Please practice physical distancing while in line also.
6. Restrooms will be cleaned during all athletic events. Please wear a mask and practice physical distancing while traveling to and from the restrooms.
7. Announcers will periodically remind spectators to maintain appropriate physical distancing and wear an appropriate face covering.
8. Per MHSAA Rules: Any MHSAA activity participant who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 cannot return to play until he/she is evaluated by a licensed healthcare professional, and has written clearance to return to play by both the county health department and a licensed healthcare professional.
9. If Chouteau County reaches 4 active COVID-19 cases, masks will be required at all times, at all Fort Benton activities.
